



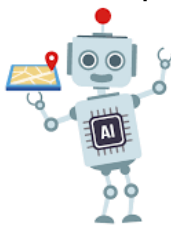

PUTTING STUDENTS IN THE CENTER

Amount

Motivating students from underserved communities to **\$858K enroll in college**

- Seeking approval of \$858,088 contract to motivate students from low-income households to take the needed steps to prepare for, and enroll in, a higher education institution or vocational program.
- Program was successfully implemented in Rhode Island and will be piloted for two years with a total of 500 students from two high schools: John C. Fremont and Mervyn M. Dymally.
- Program uses an artificial intelligence (AI) “chatbot” to text students and provide guidance and nudges to complete monthly milestones.
- Participating students can receive up to \$1,000 divided between immediate rewards for achieving milestones and savings for college.
- If successful, the program will be expanded to other schools.

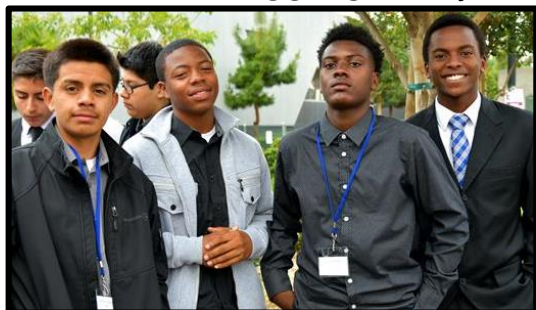


Amount

Increasing student participation and engagement

\$35K

- Seeking approval of \$35,000 contract to connect students with mentors, engage students in leadership roles, and offer conferences and other enrichment activities to prepare students for future endeavors.
- These enrichment programs help increase student participation and engagement during online learning, especially for students of color who are struggling to adjust to online learning.

Amount

- Seeking approval to ratify nine (9) revenue contracts **<\$325K>** (\$325,486) that enables Los Angeles Unified to provide administrative and support services for apprenticeship labor partners who provide training to roughly 1,700 apprentices and journey-level workers that leads to well-paid, long-term employment. Services provided include guidance, data review of students' instructional and work hours, and program audit support. **Labor Partners include:**

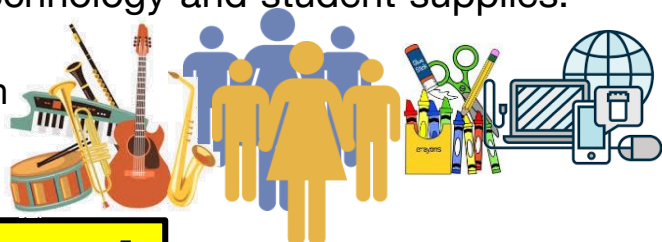

Project
Budget

Hamilton High School Comprehensive Modernization Project (BD 1, LD West, CoS Hamilton) **\$258M**

- Provides safe and updated school facilities to support 21st century learning.
- Total investment anticipated: \$257,866,948.
- Today's action: Adopt Negative Declaration and approve the project.
- New facilities include 59 classrooms within a new Science Building, Classroom and Library Building, and Performing Arts Building. A central plant, new lunch shelter, bleachers, press box and restroom/concessions buildings will also be constructed.
- Seismic retrofit of 5 buildings and various accessibility improvements.
- Running track and football field will be reconfigured, softball field will be relocated and replaced, and baseball field will be upgraded.
- At least 4,820 full-time equivalent construction related jobs anticipated to be generated.
