## Consent Items

Items for action below assigned by the Board at the meeting to be adopted by a single vote. Any item may be pulled off of consent for further discussion by any Board Member at any time before action is taken.

## New Business for Action

1. Board of Education Report No. 384 – 20/21 **ADOPTED AS AMENDED**  
Office of the Chief Financial Officer  
(1) Amend the budget to reflect the addition of \$40 million over three years for the expansion of 75 new Early Childhood Programs: \$6 million for 26 new sites in 2021-22; \$12 million for the sites opened in the previous year and an additional 25 sites in 2022-23; \$18 million for the sites opened the previous two years and an additional 25 sites in 2023-24; \$4 million for administrative costs for expansion, site readiness, curriculum development and professional development. (2) Amend the budget to include an additional \$10 million in funding for the Partners for Student Success Program from unallocated funds. Funding will be set aside for partnerships with indigenous organizations and Tribes to support indigenous students and ensure schools are places that affirm their unique histories and linguistic and cultural backgrounds. (3) Amend the budget to include an additional \$56.7 million from unallocated funds to provide additional investment in our Black Student Achievement Plan (BSAP), to be allocated as follows: Community Based Safety Pilots (safe passage programs, peace building initiatives, community intervention programs etc.), \$15 million; Climate Coaches at 53 BSAP elementary schools, \$2.7 million; Counselors at schools with 100 or more Black students (an additional 57 schools), \$7 million; Auxiliary courses at all BSAP secondary schools (60) and support to recruit and assist teachers in becoming properly credentialed for these courses, \$2 million; Expansion of community partnerships, \$14 million; With the support of nationally recognized experts, audit the District's curriculum and develop a plan to shift culturally and linguistically responsive curricula and instructional materials District-wide, \$5 million; Educator release time, substitute coverage, and high-quality training on anti-racist and culturally

responsive pedagogy and teaching practices at BSAP schools (allocated on a per pupil count), \$10 million; Administrative support for BSAP schools, \$1 million. (4) Amend the budget to add \$2 million for advancing the AANHPI AMEMSA (Asian, American, Native Hawaiian, Pacific Islander, Arab, Middle Eastern, Muslim, South Asian) – Protect our Students Initiative.

(Adoption of the Proposed 2021-22 Budget) Recommends adoption of the proposed 2021-22 budget; approval of the delegation of authority to the Budget Services and Financial Planning Division and the Accounting Disbursements Division to take all necessary actions to implement the Budget Assumptions and Policies; approval of the Resolution Regarding Expenditures from the Educational Protection Account for fiscal year 2021-22; and approval of the delegation of authority to District staff to make interfund transfers or temporary borrowings among the District' various funds.

2. Board of Education Report No. 389 – 20/21 **ADOPTED**  
Office of the Chief Strategy Officer  
(Adoption of the District Local Control and Accountability Plan) Recommends the adoption of the District's Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP), describing how the District will implement programs and policies to support all students in the Local Control Funding Formula priority areas, as well as how the District will leverage supplemental and concentration funds to improve services for English learners, students in foster care, and low-income students.
  
3. Board of Education Report No. 390 – 20/21 **ADOPTED BY CONSENT VOTE**

(Adoption of Affiliated Charter Schools' Local Control and Accountability Plan) Recommends the adoption of the Affiliated Charter Schools' Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP), allowing the District to meet the state mandated requirement.
  
4. Board of Education Report No. 418-20/21 **ADOPTED BY CONSENT VOTE**  
Office of Labor Relations  
(UTLA – LAUSD Sideletter Agreement on Return to Traditional Instruction for the 2021-22 School Year) Recommends approval of the Sideletter Agreement with United Teachers Los Angeles (UTLA) related to health and safety conditions for in person instruction.
  
5. Board of Education Report No. 420-20/21 **ADOPTED BY CONSENT VOTE**  
Human Resources Division  
(Routine Personnel) Recommends approval of employment contracts for specified senior management employees appointed by the Board in the June 8, 2021 Regular Board Meeting.
  
6. Board of Education Report No. 419-20/21 **ADOPTED BY CONSENT VOTE**  
Office of Labor Relations  
(SEIU Local 99 - LAUSD 2019-20 Reopener Agreements for Bargaining Units B, C, F and G) Recommends approval of Reopener Agreements with Service Employees International Union (SEIU) for Units B, C, F and G related to specified compensation agreements.
