## **PARTNERSHIPS PROVIDE GREENING PROJECTS AT SCHOOLS**

### **Urban Greening Project at Buchanan St. Elementary** Amount **(\$1.1M)**

- Seeking authorization to execute agreements with environmental non-profit organization North East Trees (NET) for construction of Urban Greening Project at Buchanan St. Elementary located in Local District Central and Board District 5.
- Project will provide additional green space, an outdoor learning classroom/garden, a small fruit orchard, new play structures, native gardens, shade trees and outdoor nature play areas.
- Funded by \$1,088,980 State grant secured by NET.



### **Urban Greening Projects at Multiple Schools** Amount **(\$1.1M)**

- Seeking authorization to execute agreements with environmental non-profit organization Los Angeles Beautification Team (LABT) for construction of Urban Greening Projects at Berendo Middle, Kingsley Elementary, Wadsworth Elementary and Logan Academy of Global Ecology representing Local Districts Central & West and Board Districts 2 & 5.
- Projects will provide additional green space, shade trees, and outdoor nature play areas throughout the campuses.
- Funded by State grants totaling \$1,127,211 secured by LABT.

### GRANT PROVIDES SUMMER BRIDGE PROGRAM SUPPORT

Amount

- Seeking ratification of three contracts totaling \$575,967 for **\$576K** Linked Learning Summer Bridge support activities including:
  - Work-based learning activity development
  - Securing industry speakers
  - Curriculum design and implementation
  - Teacher training on curriculum
- Funded by Strong Workforce Program grant from State.
- Supports summer 2020 and summer 2021.
- Impacts 30 Linked Learning schools across all six Local Districts and all seven Board Districts that serve our most vulnerable populations including Foster Youth, African American students, English Learners and Special Education students.
- Linked Learning increases students' college and career readiness by providing relevant and motivating education experiences that connect learning to real-world situations and career pathways.
