Continuous Improvement Data Committee

Purpose: The Continuous Improvement Data Committee will review key District initiatives that use data to enhance equity, improve student outcomes, and support district functioning. Upon review, discussion, and stakeholder input regarding these initiatives, the Committee may provide recommendations to the Board of Education about how the District can best use data to support school and district improvement.

Goals/Outcomes: Over the course of the 19/20 school year, the Committee will review information, discuss, and make recommendations to the Board and Superintendet on initiatives as described below.

- 1. **Open Data**: The Committee will periodically review updates to and new data available through the Open Data transparency initiative. The Committee may make recommendations for additional data sets and the continued development of Open Data in the 2020-2021 school year.
- 2. **Student Achievement & Outcome Data:** The Committee will review data regarding student performance and how the District is using such data. The Committee may make recommendations regarding (1) additional metrics that the District can use to understand how students are learning; and (2) strategies to ensure the District is utilizing student achievement data to inform continuous improvement efforts.
- 3. **Enrollment:** The Committee will review data regarding enrollment practices and outcomes, including through the Unified Enrollment platform that is currently available for schools of choice. The Committee will provide recommendations for enrollment policies to promote an improved enrollment experience, equitable enrollment practices, and the use of enrollment data to drive instructional programming.
- 4. **ITD Division:** The Committee will review practices of the District's Information & Technology Division related to programs impacting student enrollment, progress, and performance, including analysis of relevant portions of recent external audits and/or studies, and may provide recommendations to ensure that ITD's services are aligned with and supporting District priorities and programs.
