### **Huntington Park High School Comprehensive Modernization Project (BD 5, LD East, CoS Huntington Park/Vernon)**

**\$97.2M**

- Anticipated total investment: \$150M
- Today's action: Award of \$97.2M construction contract
- New facilities include two new classroom buildings (22 general and specialty classrooms), a gymnasium, and a pool facility.
- The Administration and Science Buildings, and Shops Buildings 1 & 2 will be renovated.
- Provides safe and updated facilities to support 21<sup>st</sup> century learning.
- At least 2,800 full-time equivalent construction related jobs anticipated to be generated.

## GRANT SUPPORTS PUTTING STUDENTS IN THE CENTER

Amount

**Los Angeles Unified is one of two school districts across the country awarded Federal Student-Centered Funding Grant** **\$583K**

- Competitive, federal grant pilot from Department of Education to encourage districts to implement student-centered funding (SCF)— a weighted student funding formula.
- Combines federal, state and local funds into a single funding formula that allocates resources based on students needs.
- Provides greater budget transparency and flexibility for school leaders so they can focus on meeting students needs instead of compliance requirements for multiple funding sources.
- Builds on current Student Equity Needs Index (SENI) funding at schools that represents just 4% of total school budgets; Majority of balance comes from state Local Control Funding Formula funds allocated through class-sizes (norming tables).
- Initial one-year grant (\$583K) will be used to assess current-state and design a weighted student funding formula.
- Plan to apply for additional \$1.7M grant to implement and monitor success for four (4) years.
