BOARD REPORT

Action Proposed: The administration seeks authorization to submit the revised CCTP Phase 2 and Beyond Plan to the Bond Oversight Committee for their review at their November 20th meeting.

Background: The Board authorized the initial phase of the Common Core Technology Project. This was a small stage (5% of the total rollout), but of course, large by normal standards because we are LAUSD. This initial phase was deliberately designed to test and learn about all of the following: technical infrastructure of schools, security, professional development for teachers and principals, curricular materials, assessments, digital content, and processing all of the above with students. We have seen many amazing possibilities and have been humbled by the immediate opportunities for our youth.

We have learned a great deal from this initial phase that will allow us to improve the rollout to additional students if the board decides to move forward with this initiative. We have also learned from our youth, teachers, administrators, and staff. We have constructed a communications plan, toolkits and source materials of support, and have collected data. Our initial project was for 47 schools. We have chosen our schools in this phase and our other planned phases by being guided by our obligations to our commitment to equity, access, and to our Office for Civil Rights (OCR) consent agreement.

Expected Outcomes:

- Approval of the plan will ensure that schools are ready to administer the Smarter Balanced Field Tests in the spring of 2014.
- The Common Core Technology Project will expand to include



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approximately 36 OCR and non-OCR campuses to allow for a more comprehensive evaluation.

- Implementation of Phase 2 will put the District on track to be in compliance with the Office for Civil Rights Resource Comparability Agreement.
- The plan will provide all school-based administrators and certificated staff with a tablet that will allow them to preview and prepare for full deployment.

Board Options and Consequences: Supports administration's revised plan prior to submission to the Bond Oversight Committee.

Policy Implications:

Budget Impact: Upon review from the BOC, the CCTP budget will be adjusted. Since the plan will be funded with bond dollars, the budget must first be reviewed and approved by the BOC.
