Action Proposed:

Approval of Employment Contract for Superintendent of Schools

Background:

The Board of Education has held several meetings concerning the selection of a Superintendent of Schools to succeed Michelle King. In the event that the Board makes a selection on April 17, 2018, this action item is being agendized so that the Board may consider the employment contract for the Superintendent of Schools.

This item will not be necessary if none is selected.

Expected Outcomes:

Approval of the employment contract of the Superintendent of Schools, the terms of which have not yet been determined.

Board Options and Consequences:

The Board may approve the contract. If the Board does not approve a contract, the terms of the employment will not have been agreed upon in writing as required under the law.

Policy Implications:

The District historically has entered into written employment contracts with the Superintendent of Schools. If the Board does not approve contract, the terms of the employment will not have been agreed upon in writing and will not meet the legal requirements.

Budget Impact:

To be determined.

Issues and Analysis:

In the event that the Board makes a selection on April 17, 2018, this action item being agendized so that the Board may consider the employment contract for the Superintendent of Schools. This item will not be necessary if none is selected.
